

## BugShot 2019 – SoCal **Steele/Burnand Anza-Borrego Desert Research Center**

### **Application for Student Fee Waiver**

BugShot 2019 has 2 fee waivers available for currently enrolled university students (undergraduate and graduate) and older high school students (age 15+). These waivers allow students to enroll without paying fees, and they will cover food, housing and all scheduled events at the workshop. Fee waivers do NOT provide travel reimbursements to and from the event.

To apply for a student fee waiver, please submit the following:

1. A copy of a student identification card, or equivalent evidence of student status.
2. A brief, 300-500 word explanation of how photography intersects with your work & career interests, and what you hope to learn at BugShot.
3. A 10-image portfolio of your photographic work (can be submitted as a link to a Flickr, G+, SmugMug, Tumblr or other online gallery).

We will continue to receive student applications until March 1, 2019. Instructors will then review the applications and will reply by March 8th. We anticipate receiving more applications than available slots, so acceptance is a competitive process and not everyone who applies will receive a waiver.

Students who receive a fee waiver will be registered automatically for BugShot and will not need to register online. Students who do not receive a fee waiver may still register for the event if space remains available. Note that if you apply for a waiver, do not receive it, and the course has filled, you will not be able to attend unless other registrants cancel. The only way to guarantee admission is to purchase a regular registration.
